

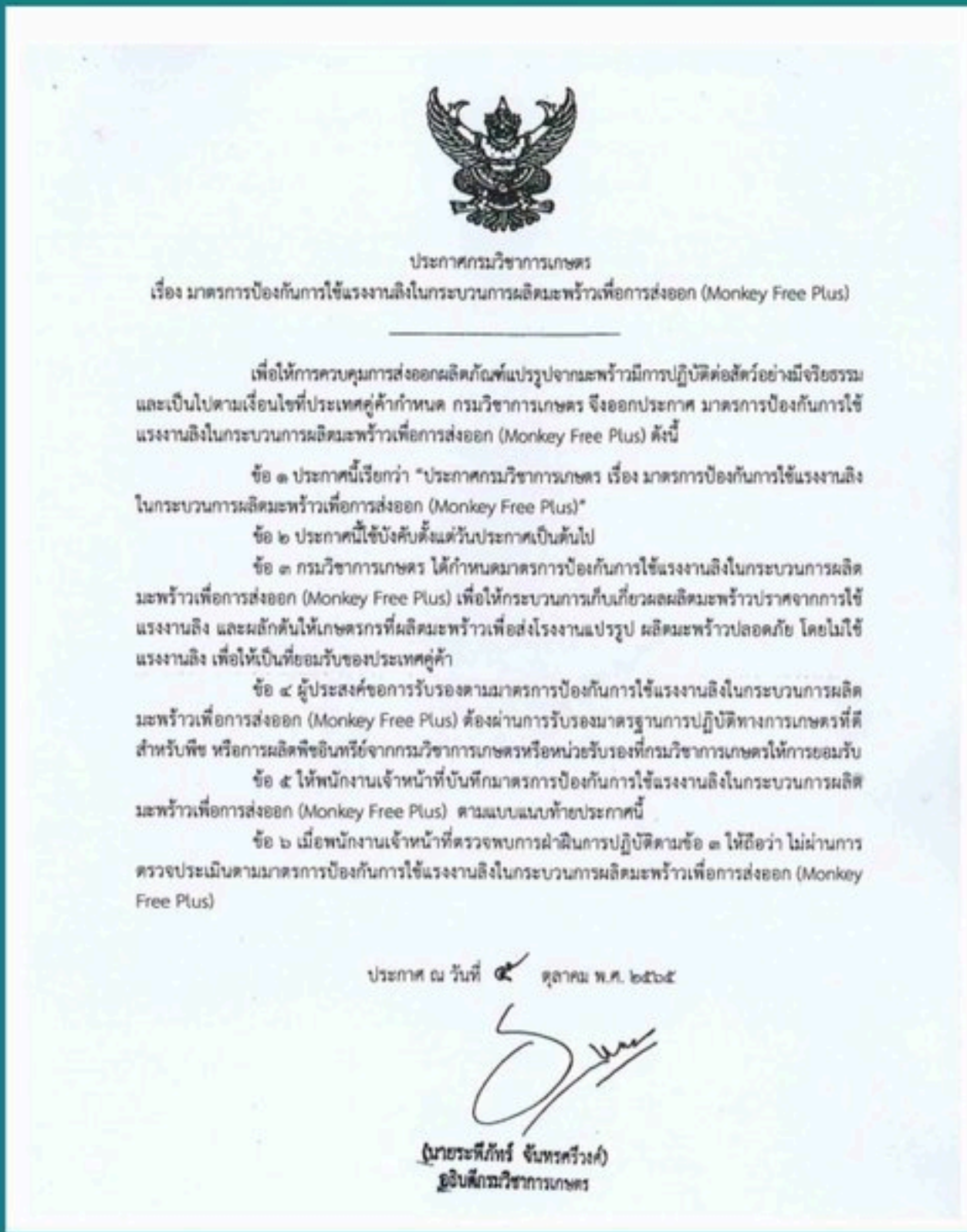
# THE PROCEDURE OF ASSESSMENT OF COCONUT FARMS FOR MONKEY FREE PLUS



## Objective

This project aims to widely promote “Good Agricultural Practice (GAP)” or “Organic” Standards, together with Monkey Free Plus measures (MFP) to coconut farms in Thailand, to ensure quality of coconut products, and to prevent using monkeys labor in harvesting process.

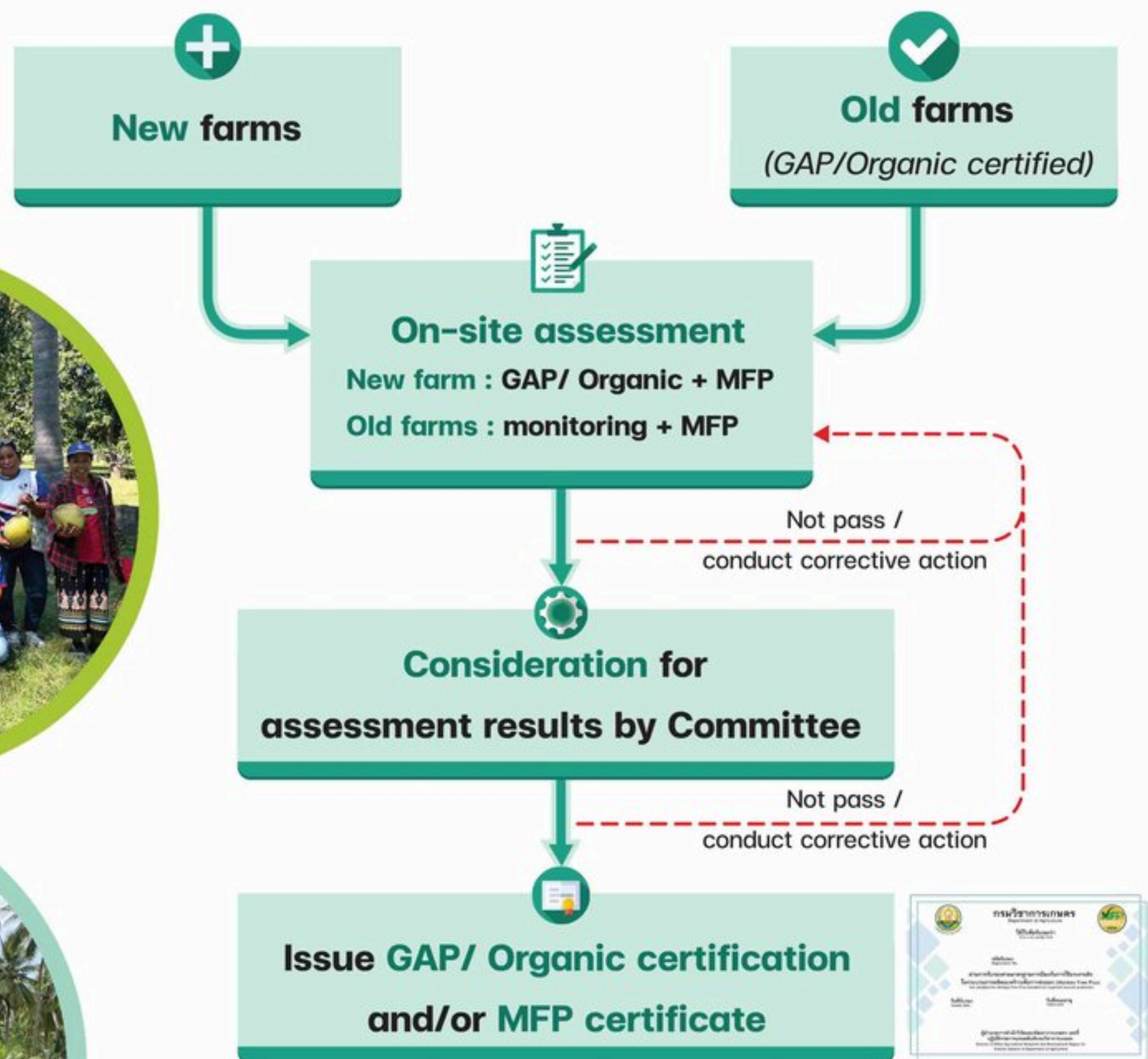
### Notification on MFP measures for coconut farms



DOA’s auditor team will conduct on-site assessment for MFP using specific checklist, which include the following requirements:

- 1 Harvesting coconut produces by human
- 2 Harvesting coconut produces by instruments
- 3 Do not use any monkeys labor in harvesting process
- 4 Does not breed monkey for harvesting propose in farm
- 5 Does not use outsource that using monkey in harvesting process
- 6 Have a plan to replanting with dwarf and hybrid coconut varieties

## Impact

- Coconut farms have GAP/Organic certified without using monkeys labor in harvesting process
- Manufacturers have sufficient raw materials sourced from quality and monkey-free coconut farms for their production and processing
