## MOAC discussed with UN Food Systems Coordination Hub, Moving forward to transforming food system



Mr. Sedthakiat Krajangwongs, Deputy Permanent Secretary, Ministry of Agriculture and Cooperatives, along with Dr. Vanida Khumnirdpetch, Director of Bureau of Foreign Agricultural Affairs, Ms. Ratchanok Sangpenchan, Acting Minister Counsellor (Agricultural), Ms. Supajit Sriariyawat, Counsellor (Agricultural), Office of Agricultural Affairs - Royal Thai Embassy - Rome, paid a visit to Mr. Stefanos Fotiou, Head of the UN Food Systems Coordination Hub, and Mr. Svante Helms, Manager of

National Pathway. Both parties explored ways to improve collaboration and promote food system transformation in order to accomplish the Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). The UN Food Systems Coordination Hub is a structure with the primary function of coordinating and exchanging information among organizations and partners to enhance and support food system communication.

During the discussions, the Deputy Permanent Secretary presented Thailand's efforts towards building the National Pathway and transforming an earlier food system. In this instance, he requested that the United Nations consider providing academic assistance and access to budget resources to develop a stable and sustainable Thai food system as well as supporting Thailand's participation in the 2023 United Nations Climate Change Conference (COP 28), which will take place between November 30 and December 12, 2023.
